NWEBA League Structure 2015 Season

The current league structure whereby the clubs were split into two sections was largely based upon geographical lines owing to the long time it took to travel around the North West Essex area. The road transport links have been improved tremendously since that time and it is time to re-evaluate whether this is the best way to organize the league structure.

At the present time Section 1 has 9 teams in Division C with a 10th team (Witham Mill Lane B) wishing to join. This is not possible given the current structure as we cannot accommodate 10 teams in a division and still provide 7 home and 7 away fixtures for all the teams.

It is therefore time to allow for future expansion rather than turn teams away.

The proposal is to combine the top four teams in Sections 1 and 2 into a single new Division A. To combine the remaining four teams in sections 1 and 2 into a new Division B (after allowing for promotions and relegations based on this seasons results).

This would be repeated in a similar manner for the existing Division B and Division C in Sections 1 and 2. This process would result in 5 Divisions of 8 teams and 1 Division of 6 Teams allowing Witham Mill Lane B to join the league. Each team would play 7 home and 7 away fixtures. The new structure and team make up is shown below.
